Verified Canadian Pork™ is built on the foundation of Canada's on-farm national standards for food safety, animal care, and traceability, combined with Canada's world-class meat inspection system through HACCP-approved processing facilities.



Canadian Pork Excellence.

Canadian Pork Excellence (CPE) is the national platform for three programs that support on-farm quality assurance including food safety, animal care, and traceability.

PigSAFE promotes and ensures best on-farm practices. Based on HACCP (Hazard Analysis Critical Control Point) principles, PigSAFE requires detailed record-keeping validated annually by an official auditor.

PigCARE is an auditable program that examines the environment, comfort, nutrition, health, and housing of pigs to ensure the highest standards of animal care are maintained.

PigTRACE is a mandatory identification and traceability system for pigs to protect herd health. It is administered by the Canadian Pork Council with support from Agriculture Canada.
